The process for elected office

- * Nominations—any NEKAAL member over 16 is eligible to serve. You can nominate yourself or any member to any position. Your nominations can be given to any board member or through the website.
- * Notification— nominees are contacted and asked if they will accept nomination. Those who accept nomination are placed on the ballot.
- * Ballots are provided to members prior to the December meeting/party. Completed ballots can be sent to the secretary, or brought to the party. Since all officers are automatically on the board, a vote for an officer also counts as a vote for the board.
- * During the party, votes are counted and the new officers and board members announced.

The process for awards

Astronomer of the Year—a person who has made a considerable contribution to astronomy and/or NEKAAL

Rising Star—a person relatively who has made great strides in their knowledge of or activity in astronomy

To nominate someone for either award, write a brief explanation of why your nominee deserves the award, and send it to the president, Brian Martin. Nominations are due on November 1. The president reviews the nominations and chooses a recipient for the year. (NOTE: awards are not mandatory)
