## NOTE:

The Orionid meteor shower occurs just a few days after new moon. Since the moon will early, meteor viewing should be good.

## Planets Visible This Month

- **Venus** Rising in the eastern sky just 2 hours before dawn on the 1<sup>st</sup>, but only 90 minutes before by the 31<sup>st</sup>. Magnitude -3.9,
- **Mars** Mars rises around 1 a.m. at magnitude +0.8. Starts the month in Gemini, moves into Cancer by month's end
- Jupiter— The only bright planet visible before midnight, although it sets by 1 a.m. Magnitude -2.6 in Capricornus.
- **Saturn** barely emerging from the sun's glare in the early morning sky.
